### UNMISS “PROTECTION OF CIVILIANS” (PoC) SITES <sup>1</sup>

- As of 10 December, the estimated number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is 185,033 including 106,069 in Bentiu, 27,950 in Juba UN House, 47,791 in Malakal, 2,289 in Bor, 700 in Melut and 234 in Wau.
