Simultaneous interpretation will be provided during the meeting in the following languages; English, Arabic, French and Portuguese.

Due to the large number of participants and the currency restrictions in the host country, the UN will cater for your accommodation and all meals. Travel:

It is the responsibility of participants to ensure that they are in possession of all necessary visas and transit visas for their travel to and from Ethiopia. Participants who are nationals of or have permanent residence permit in one of the eligible countries can apply for e-Visa. 
Those who do not require visas: Visas will be gratis for those in possession of diplomatic IDs upon presentation of your letter of invitation to the meetings.

Yellow fever vaccination: Visitors coming into Ethiopia must possess valid yellow fever vaccination certificates. In the country, itself, precautions are needed against malaria fever, which is common in some places.

Medical Services:

The African Union clinic will provide emergency medical services to the participants attending the meeting.

Weather: November is relatively cold with temperatures averaging max 23 °C (73 °F) and min average t°: +7 °C (44 °F). Delegates are advised to plan their wardrobes accordingly.



Language: English is the official business language for Ethiopia while the most commonly used local language is Amharic. Arabic, Italian and French are widely spoken by many foreigners residing in Ethiopia.

Time Zone: Standard Time in Ethiopia is three hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT +3) hours

Currency: The local currency is the Ethiopian Birr (ETB). The current average exchange rates are (approximately) ETB 29.7 = US\$ 1. Bureau de change facilities are widely available. Credit cards are not widely used in Ethiopia. There is restriction on the amount of foreign currency capped at USD 3000.

Voltage: In Ethiopia, the standard voltage is 220 V and the frequency is 50 Hz. Wall sockets are two pronged. Delegates are advised to bring adapters.

Banking hours: Are from 0800hrs to 1600hrs on weekdays and from 0800hrs to 1200hrs on Saturdays.

Communications: The government owned operator, the Ethiopian Telecommunication Corporation (ETC), provides PSTN, mobile telephone, Internet and data communication services. Cell phone sim cards are widely available. However, every sim card user in Ethiopia is expected by law to be registered for activation. The sim card can be registered at the point of purchase; passport is required for sim card activation.
